1. TGA bill proposal, brought forward by Councilmembers Terry and Groeteke

Summary: would modify sections of the UDO to allow subdivision developers to be charged a Traffic Generation Fee to offset costs related to future road and bridge upgrades

2. GB bill proposal, brought forward by Councilman Groeteke

Summary: would eliminate double permit requirements for erosion control projects for private landowners holding valid permits issued by the Army Corps of Engineers

3. EDGE 6 resolution draft, brought forward by Councilman Groeteke

Summary: would expedite government action on projects projected to have a significant impact on economic growth

4. Amendment to Code Section 400.950, brought forward by Councilman Groeteke

Summary: which would add a requirement that the Jefferson County Stormwater Division submit a stormwater impact report during the approval process for any development, redevelopment or rezoning of over an acre in the urbanized area of Jefferson County

5. Public Nuisance, brought forward by Councilman Haskins

Summary: Possible amendment to correct a missing word in the Public Nuisance/Tall Weeds bill, now Ordinance 20-0221 to add the words "or vegetation" under Item #15 – noxious weeds.
