5	WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance 19-0263 Jefferson County, Missouri
6	purchased the Appia Software Licenses from Info Tech for the Public Works Department
7	to manage federally funded road and bridge projects.
8	WHEREAS, Jefferson County, Missouri, (hereafter, the "County") Department of
9	Public Works desires to renew the purchase Appia Software Licenses from Info Tech who
10	is the owner, sole licensor, and sole provider of the Appia service for construction
11	administration; and
12	WHEREAS, the Info Tech application is the only solution that is approved by
13	MoDOT for employing the following set of requirements to meet Jefferson County's needs
14	in the area of Contract Administration Software; and
15	WHEREAS, this is the only software that MoDOT and FHWA allow for official
16	project documentation and archiving; and since the current project documentation is
17	handwritten, this will improve efficiency in the process; and
18	WHEREAS, the products are based on software meeting MoDOT's requirements
19	for source documentation of contract administration of federal aid construction projects

1	and are approved for use as electronic alternatives to securely bound project field book

3	WHEREAS, Department of Public Works is requesting to purchase five (5) Appia	
4	Software Licenses from Info Tech; and

8	WHEREAS, Pursuant to Proposition B, which was approved by Missouri voters
9	on November 6, 2018, the minimum wage will increase Eighty-Five cents (\$0.85) per hour,
10	each year, from 2019 through 2023; and,
11	WHEREAS, While the current law does not apply to public employers in the State,
12	in order to be competitive in the job market as well as attracting and retaining a qualified
13	work force, adjustments are needed in wages provided to certain employees covered by the
14	County Employees Merit Commission; and,
15	WHEREAS, as a result of passage and implementation of Proposition B, the
16	Director of Administration and the Human Resource Department deemed it proper to
17	analyze the potential impact of Proposition B on County staff retention and recruitment
18	efforts; and,

1	WHEREAS, the County Director of Administration discussed and presented
2	recommendations, to the County Employees Merit System Commission on Monday
3	March 9, 2021; and,
4	WHEREAS, the County Director of Administration has consulted and verified
5	with the County Auditor that funds exist in the current budget for each Department to
6	support this proposal; and,
7	WHEREAS, the Jefferson County, Missouri, Council has reviewed the proposal
8	as drafted and recommended by the County Executive, the Director of Administration and
9	the County Employees Merit System Commission and finds that it is consistent and ir
10	harmony with the requirements and principles set forth in the Personnel Administration
11	Program and the Home Rule Charter of Jefferson County, Missouri.
