- m. Petition PM21063 does not satisfy the criteria set forth by the UDO in that the proposed rezoning and development plan would detrimentally impact the adjacent properties in that the proposed facility will negatively affect property values of other businesses in the neighborhood.
- n. Petition PM21063 does not satisfy the criteria set forth by the UDO in that the proposed rezoning and development plan would detrimentally impact the adjacent properties in that the subject property does not provide adequate space for a successful storage facility.

6	WHEREAS, Petitioner Fair View Holdings, LLC, "Petitioner" did on the 11th
7	day of August, 2021, file with Jefferson County, Missouri, through the Department of the
8	County Clerk, a Petition styled "Petition to Vacate a Segment of Silver Lane" which is
9	hereinafter referred to as the "Petition to Vacate[;]" and which is attached hereto as
