- **6/22/23 Light EOC Activation;** Closure of Super 8 where we were able to put a family in contact with The Red Cross.
- **Outdoor Warning Sirens Update;** Presentation by ATI Systems, Boston, MA. Bob McLaughlin went over a proposal of where & type of sirens. The first included 238 sirens in unincorporated Jefferson County that were 3200 watts. The second was with 137 sirens in high density unincorporated areas (population of > 2,000/ square mile. They will be able to help with placement and go over the factors involved with why they are suggesting that particular location. It can also have automated alerts from the National Weather Service.

- **Mobile Integrated Health Care Summit;** This is being held in St. Charles, MO August 1-3. It will cover a variety of jurisdictions and be held at the St. Charles Convention Center.
