Remove Sheet 11 of 75 from the project specifications, and replace with sheet ADD 1-2, new sheet 11 of 75. The purpose of the replacement is to add the asphalt index pricing option to the contract.

1. The undersigned BIDDER proposes and agrees, if this BID is accepted, to enter into an Agreement with the County in the form included in the Contract Documents to complete all Work as specified or indicated in the Contract Documents for the Contract Price and within the Contract Time indicated in this Bid and in accordance with the Contract Documents.
  2. BIDDER accepts all of the terms and conditions of the Instructions to Bidders. This Bid will remain open for sixty days after the day of Bid opening. BIDDER will sign the Agreement and submit all documents required within fifteen (15) days after the COUNTY'S Notice of Award.
  3. In submitting this Bid, BIDDER represents, as more fully set forth in the Agreement, that:
    - (a) BIDDER has examined the site and locality where the Work is to be performed, the legal requirements (federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules and regulations) and the conditions affecting cost, progress or performance of the Work and has made such independent investigations as BIDDER deems necessary; and
    - (b) This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed person, firm or corporation and is not submitted in conformity with any agreement or rules of any group, association, organization or corporation; BIDDER has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid; BIDDER has not solicited or induced any person, firm or a corporation to refrain from bidding; and BIDDER has not sought by collusion to obtain for himself any advantage over any other Bidder or over the County.
  4. **Optional Asphalt Index Pricing.** This provision is optional. If the bidder wishes to be bound by this provision, the bidder shall execute the acceptance by checking the box in this section. Failure by the bidder to execute the acceptance form shall be interpreted as an election to not participate in the Asphalt Cement Price Index. Accepting this provision waives any right to request material allowance payment for any products relevant to this provision. Price adjustments will be made to the contract unit price, to reflect changes in prices, of the actual amount of virgin PG asphalt binder used in any plant mix bituminous base, plant mix bituminous pavement, plant mix bituminous surface leveling, asphaltic concrete pavement and ultrathin bonded asphalt wearing surface that contains performance graded (PG) asphalt binder when it has been determined that the Monthly Asphalt Index for the month prior to placement of the asphalt mixture has fluctuated from the Monthly Asphalt Index for the month the project was let. The Monthly Asphalt Index shall be as published at the following web address:

The percentage of virgin PG asphalt binder as shown in the job mix formula, and in accordance with Sec 401, Sec 403 and Sec 413 of the Missouri Standard Specifications, will be the basis for price adjustments for any asphalt mix type placed on the project. The effective asphalt binder obtained from the use of Recycled Asphalt Pavement (RAP) and/or Recycled Asphalt Shingles (RAS) will not be eligible for adjustment.  
To determine the price adjustment for any asphalt mix specified in this provision, the following formula will be used.  
$$A = (B \times C/100) \times (D-E)$$
  
Where: A = Dollar value adjustment for mix placed during the payment estimate period  
B = Tons of asphalt mixture placed during the payment estimate period  
C = Percent of virgin PG asphalt binder as listed in the job mix formula in use  
D = The Monthly Asphalt Index for the month prior to the month the asphalt mix was placed (INITIALS)  
E = The asphalt base index = the Monthly Asphalt Index for the month the project was let

5. Bidder will complete the project for the following unit prices. It is understood that the quantities given for the following bid items are not guaranteed by the Jefferson County Public Works Department and are used solely for the purpose of comparing bids and awarding the contract, and may or may not represent the actual quantities encountered on the job, and that the sum of quantities listed below, multiplied by the unit price shall constitute the gross sum bid.
