3 Section 1. The County authorizes the renewal of the bid awards for an

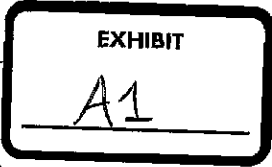




